ENTRY KIOSK

Because of COVID-19, health screenings are the new norm for entering many types of buildings. For communities like ours, this is the first line of defense for keeping our campus infection-free. Through proper screening, we determine if people have a temperature, symptoms of illness, or known exposure to sick people.

Traditional paper and pen screening processes are cumbersome, time-consuming, and not fully effective.

You can help prevent infection in our community by supporting ADF's investment in a new Health Entry Screening Program. Using an advanced automated kiosk with facial recognition and biometric capabilities, our program will make it safer for the people living, working, and visiting our community.

- Increased safety since people who pose health risks will not remain on campus
- Improved contact tracing through automated data collection
